Planned activities

Our babies follow a loose weekly plan, based on their interests and developmental needs. Below are some of the overall steps that we work on with your children during their time in this room.

In the 0-2s room I am working towards:

- Being able to sit and concentrate at an activity of my choice for a short period of time, join in with group time doing actions and dancing to music.
- Being able to understand and follow simple instructions.
- Beginning to put two words together.
- Be able to go up and down stairs holding onto something.
- Running and moving safely and having spatial awareness.
- Finding out my dominant hand and starting to use a pincer grip when drawing sometimes copying a line or circle.
- Using my imagination in play, pretending things are something else or acting out things I have seen.
- Starting to be able to sit on a chair at a table using a big cup to drink from and using a spoon/ fork to eat with.
- Showing a sign for recognising wet/ soiled nappy or being interested in toileting and self care.
- Saying some number names or begin to count.
- Interested in books with others and by myself.
- Joining in with sensory and messy play with a range of ideas and tools.
