<u>Planned activities</u>

Our two year olds follow a loose weekly plan, based on their interests and developmental needs.

By the time I leave this room I will be a Confident learner, able to manage my feelings and understand the need to share and take turns. I will use my words to explain what I want and try to come up with ideas of how to achieve this. I will be starting to enjoy and respect my outdoor environment and identify changes and patterns around me. I am developing my gross motor and fine motor skills and am becoming more independent in my self Care needs.

Communication & Language

Listen and respond well to instructions. Be able to talk in full sentences and ask simple questions. Understand simple concepts and complex sentences Have a wide, ever increasing range of vocabulary

Physical Development

Be able to Climb and move independently in a range of ways.

Hold mark making equipment with increasing control

Sit well at mealtimes and using Cutlery appropriately.

Become independent with self-care such as putting on my coat ϕ shoes and washing my hands Clearly communicate my need to use the potty / toilet

Personal development and Relationships

Play alongside others, sharing and turn taking to develop friendships Join in effectively at group times, sitting nicely and participating well. Follow routines, understand the structure of the day and expectations within the room Build a relationship with my adult Carers.

Learn how to express my Choices and feelings appropriately

<u>Maths</u>

Identify some numbers, colours and shapes in the environment. Understand number sequencing to 5 (ideally 10) Use mathematical language regarding more / less / add to / big / small Start to match quantity and numeral

<u>Literacy</u>

Start to develop a love of books and songs and find my favourites Repeat familiar phrases from some stories Start to distinguish between the different marks I make.

Understanding the world around me

Engage with role play areas to further my play and use appropriate resources. Enjoy being outside and become aware of Changes in nature and our environment Imitate everyday actions in my pretend play with friends

Expressive arts

Become confident in exploring sensory activities and expressing themselves Creatively. Explore sound through musical instruments and song

Our two year olds use the front garden which allows us to bring them out in small tailored groups, or larger ones depending on the activities for the day.

<u>Our Space</u>

Our two year olds benefit from a larger area to explore themed role play areas, such as a busy home corner and a construction area.

We work on lots of early maths and language skills at this age and you will see areas and activities linked to this objective.

There are lots of messy activities on offer throughout the day, which are set up outside of their main room, so that they have a choice of what they get involved in and when.

(We also have a separate sleep room for when it all gets too much!)
