Our babies follow a loose weekly plan, based on their interests and developmental needs. Below are some of the overall steps that we work on with your Children during their time in this room.

<ul> <li>I am copying facial expressions, then moving to being able to understand single words and beginning to follow simple instructions</li> <li>I am able to communicate my needs and wants in a variety of ways. This will include using hand gestures, some single words and the use of Makaton.</li> <li>I am developing my love of rhymes and songs and can use this to understand and copy actions and words</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>I can sit and concentrate on an activity of my choice for a short period of time.</li> <li>I am able to go up and down stairs holding on to something.</li> <li>I can run and move safely.</li> <li>I can use the palmer grip when drawing and will sometimes copy a line or circle and make my own marks.</li> <li>I can build a tower of three or more bricks confidently.</li> <li>I can move independently using a variety of movements. I am a confident walker but may need help with balance on occasions.</li> <li>I enjoy fitting into different spaces such as tunnels, large boxes and enclosed spaces.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>I can build bonds with familiar adults and I am starting to play alongside other children.</li> <li>I engage with others through gestures, gaze and then talk.</li> <li>I can use my imagination in play and can act out everyday actions that I have seen.</li> <li>I demonstrate a range of emotions.</li> <li>I feel confident when taken out and about in the local area as I know that my key people are with me.</li> </ul>
